Essentris® Goes Live at Nellis AFB



Mike O'Callaghan Federal Hospital is the latest site to "go live" with *Essentris*® inpatient documentation capabilities.

On March 1-3, Nellis Air Force Base's Mike O'Callaghan Federal Hospital prepared for their upcoming "go live" with *Essentris*™. DHIMS Deployment Operations and representatives from the Air Force Surgeon General's Office were present at Nellis AFB to ensure the facility completed, or was in the process of completing, the necessary measures for this release. At present, MOFH has already had successful "go lives" in their multi-service and intensive care units.

MOFH's readiness preparation for the "go-live" included a detailed review of application and system configurations, clinical work flow preparation, formulary configuration, end user computer logistics and training readiness. Deployment Operations Air Force Liaison, Mr. Paul Degere, led the efforts of assessing the project to determine its level of readiness. Degere's contributions along with those of the project site team and hospital leadership led to a very successful release.
